POWER OUTAGE

A power outage is defined as a temporary interruption of electrical supply or service. To report a localized power outage, contact **FCC's O & M Ext. 4430**. After normal business hours, advise first available FCC Staff or Faculty member.

In the event of a large-scale power outage:

- If building evacuation becomes necessary, seek out persons with functional needs and provide assistance if possible. If additional assistance is necessary, advise first available FCC staff or Faculty member.
- Secure all vital equipment, records, experiments, and hazardous materials if safe to do so.
 Store all chemicals in their original or marked containers and fully open all fume hoods.
 If this is not possible, or natural ventilation is not adequate, evacuate the area until power is restored.
- Do not light candles or other types of flames for lighting or heating purposes.
- Unplug electrical equipment, including computers, and turn *off* the light switches.
- Follow directions provided by Public Safety through the established Emergency Notification Systems, i.e.: IECC-Alerts.
