WEAPONS SITUATION

General Guidelines

- 1. Assess the situation.
- 2. Notify police (call 911).
- 3. Isolate subject(s) from the weapon or other persons if it is safe to do so.
- 4. Do not unnecessarily use force or touch the person or weapon.
- 5. Remain calm.
- 6. Notify the President or designee (ext. 3383).
- 7. If a weapon is surrendered to, or recovered by, staff or faculty prior to police arrival, place it in an empty container, (trash can, etc.) and place in a secured area until police arrive.

Level 1 Threat: A Rumor That Someone has a Weapon

Level 2 Threat: Weapon Witnessed, but no Immediate Danger

Level 3 Immediate Action: Weapon Use Threatened or Carried Out

Active Shooter

- 1. In the event gunfire erupts on campus call 911 and use the term "ACTIVE SHOOTER".
- 2. Notify the President or designee (ext. 3383).
- 3. While in shelters or rooms:
 - a. Avoid windows and doors
 - b. Remain as quiet as possible
 - c. Lock doors and turn off lights.
- 4. Remain in safe position until the "ALL CLEAR" message is received.
