AGREEMENT BETWEEN VINCENNES UNIVERSITY

Bachelor of Science in Special Education, Mild Intervention, K-12 AND

Illinois Eastern Community College Associate Degree

Statement of Intent

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a framework for the transfer of credits earned in the Associate of Science degree at Illinois Eastern Community College (IECC) to the Bachelor of Science at Vincennes University.

The faculty of both institutions have worked together to develop the attached listing of course equivalencies, course requirements for the Associate degree, and course requirements for the completion of the Baccalaureate degree. The agreement is in effect for courses taken beginning the 2020 Fall semester. All course work taken prior to the 2020 Fall semester will be evaluated by Vincennes University faculty to determine transfer of course work.

This agreement will remain in effect until one party decides to terminate it, with 60 days advance notice. This agreement, including any modifications, may be reviewed by either institution upon request. Both institutions agree to keep the other aware of curriculum changes as they occur, and the agreement should be reviewed every three years. While both parties to the agreement understand its purpose is to maximize transfer opportunities for student, they also recognize the limits may be placed on courses accepted under the provisions of this agreement, should the student subsequently decide to change to another program not covered by the agreement.

Transfer Agreement

Between

Vincennes University (VU)

And

Illinois Eastern Community College (IECC)

For transfer of Illinois Eastern Community College's Associate of Science and Arts with a concentration in Education degree to Vincennes University's Bachelor of Science in Special Education, Mild Interventions K-12

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of the transfer agreement is to provide a basis for a cooperative relationship between Vincennes University (VU) and Illinois Eastern Community College (IECC) to benefit students who desire to complete a Bachelor of Science in Special Education K-12. The intent is for students who have completed the Associate of Science and Arts with a concentration in Education at IECC to move seamlessly to the Special Education, Mild Interventions, K-12 BS program at VU. This dual licensure program prepares teacher candidates to teach in both elementary K-6 and special education classrooms, grades K-12.

Transfer Agreement

IECC graduates from the Associate of Science and Arts with a concentration in Education may transfer and apply a minimum of 64 credit hours from that completed degree to the requirements for VU's BS in Special Education.

Addendum Two: Remaining Upper and Lower Courses to Complete

Additionally, under the terms of this agreement:

1. Illinois Eastern Community College students are eligible for admission with third year standing to VU's BS Special Education program provided the student:

- a. is an IECC graduate who meets the admission requirements as approved by Vincennes University at the time of the student's admission to the BS Special Education Program.
- b. Has completed the AS with a concentration in Education with a 3.0 or higher grade point average on a 4.0-point scale;
- c. Possesses satisfactory background check and CPS check, passing CASA/Praxis scores, successful interview with faculty member, satisfactory performance evaluations, and disposition forms.
- 2. Students will be admitted to the BS Special Education, Mild Interventions K-12 program on a space-available basis.
- 3. Written notice of intention to terminate, modify, or withdraw from this Articulation Agreement will be submitted by the academic head of either institution as least one academic semester prior to the proposed date of termination/withdrawal. Should a decision be made to modify or dissolve this agreement, students who are already attending Vincennes University at the time will be permitted to continue as long as their academic performance remains in good standing.
- 4. Recognizing that changes in curricula and course content are inevitable, each institution agrees to discuss with the other institution all curriculum changes affecting this agreement before the changes are implemented.
