

Western Illinois University Dual Admission Program Informational Sheet

Western Illinois University's Dual Admission Program is intended for students that are:

1. Beginning their community college career.
 2. Attending a community college that participates in Western Illinois University's dual program
 3. Willing to grant permission for their community college to send transcripts to Western Illinois University
 4. Planning to earn an Associates of Arts and/or Science degree from that participating community college
 5. Planning to earn their Bachelor's degree from Western Illinois University
- It is extremely important that prospective transfer students pursuing majors in teacher education contact their program's advising center at Western Illinois University for current requirements. Western Illinois University must meet the mandates issued by the Illinois State Board of Education and the State Certification Board. State Certification Board requirements take precedence over the catalog of record for individuals seeking teacher certification recommendation.
 - It is recommended that prospective transfer students pursuing a major in music contact the Music department at Western Illinois University for course requirements. All students entering the music program at Western Illinois University must pass entrance performance auditions and placement examinations.

All prospective transfer students may consult the Western Illinois University admissions website www.wiu.edu or their community college adviser for course articulations from their community college to Western Illinois University.

After the completion of each semester at the community college, dual admission students will receive an evaluation of their community college coursework from Western Illinois University. This evaluation informs the student on how their courses transfer or "articulate" to Western Illinois University. Dual admitted students that declare a WIU major will additionally benefit by receiving a "WARD" report (Western's Audit of Degree Requirements). This report informs the student of Western Illinois University requirements for their intended academic major.

It is essential that we receive official transcripts from all colleges/universities you have attended other than the community college that you applied for dual admission. Without these other transcripts WIU is unable to process your dual application.
