**Board of Trustees Meeting**

The Board of Trustees of Illinois Eastern Community Colleges District No. 529 approved applications for two capital projects at the regular meeting, Tuesday, March 18, at Frontier Community College, Fairfield.

The projects are at Wabash Valley College for replacement of the roof on the Main Hall, at a cost of \$131,800, and exterior and interior wall repair at a cost of \$86,400. The projects are made possible by cancellation of a previously approved project to install a paint booth at WVC.

Project applications will be submitted to the Illinois Community College Board for approval.

The bid of Seating Systems, Inc., Farina, IL, \$117,378, was accepted for bleacher replacement at Lincoln Trail College. The project is a part of the 2002 Phase 7 Protection, Health and Safety bond issue.

The bid of Charley, Inc., Robinson, IL, \$27,232, was accepted for 37 computers for the LTC educational program at the Robinson Correctional Center.

Timothy Emmons was employed as Building Superintendent at Lincoln Trail College.

Jay Zwilling was employed as Network/Web Technician at the District Office in Olney.

Three personnel resignations were accepted. Brad Musgrave resigned as Director of Recruitment and Advisement at Lincoln Trail College, effective May 15. Stacey Bradbury resigned as Computer Technician at Olney Central College, effective March 31. Dixie Cherry resigned as Clerk/Receptionist at Frontier Community College, effective March 28.

A change was approved in the policy on "after 6 p.m." tuition waivers. Tuition of \$10 per semester hour will be charged for students enrolled in four semester hours or less per semester if the courses begin after 6 p.m. The same tuition will be charged for students enrolled in four semester hours or less before 6 p.m. if the student works a night shift on a full-time basis.

Other types of tuition waivers such as academic and athletic scholarships, special educational programs, partial waivers of tuition or workshops may be initiated by the colleges, upon recommendation of the College President with approval of the Chief Executive Officer or his designee.

Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) agreements were approved

with Crossroads Community Hospital, United Methodist Village and the Visiting Nurses Association of Evansville, IN.

An agreement for educational cooperation was approved with Southwestern Illinois College, providing for IECC to provide OSHA health and safety programs at six nursing homes in southern Illinois.

CEO Terry Bruce was authorized to settle remaining issues with the contractor on the Phase III and Phase IV construction projects.

A plaque was presented to Cory Musgrave, in recognition of and appreciation for his year of service as student member of the Board of Trustees. He is a student at Frontier Community College.

A new student trustee for the coming year will be seated at the April regular meeting.

A telephone conference meeting will be held at the IECC District Offices in Olney at 8 a.m. Tuesday, April 8, to canvass returns and proclaim results of the April 1 Board of Trustees election.

Next regular meeting of the Board of Trustees will be Tuesday, April 15, at 7 p.m. at Lincoln Trail College, Robinson.
