B. High School Completion Status

Provide **ONE** of the following documents that indicate the student's high school completion status when the student will begin college in 2018-2019.

- A copy of the student's high school diploma.
- A copy of the student's official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
- A copy of the student's GED certificate or official GED transcript that indicates the student passed the exam, or a state-authorized high school equivalent certificate.
- A copy of a DD Form 214 Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty if it indicates that you are a high school graduate or equivalent.
- An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a Bachelor's degree.
- If the student was homeschooled, a copy of the homeschool diploma or completion credential.
- If you completed high school in a foreign country and cannot obtain a copy of your high school diploma or transcript, a copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate".

If you are unable to obtain any of the items listed above, you must contact the Financial Aid Office.
