


## WHAT WE DO

The Industrial Maintenance HVAC I program provides students with the skills required to enter the field of heating, ventilation, and air conditioning.

Installation of new systems and repair to existing HVAC systems for residential and commercial (small business) purposes are covered.

This two-semester program also targets incumbent workers who desire to broaden their skills for a career change or for advancement consideration.



## WHAT YOU LEARN

HVAC technicians install and service heating, ventilation, cooling, and refrigeration systems that control the air quality in many types of buildings.

They provide maintenance and troubleshooting for systems in residential homes, schools, hospitals, office buildings, and factories. They also work on walk-in coolers, freezers, ice machines, display cases, commercial refrigerators, and water coolers.



## CAREERS

According to the U.S. Department of Labor, employers nationwide are reporting a shortage of qualified HVAC technicians. The Bureau of Labor Statistics expects jobs for HVAC technicians to grow by 21 percent in the coming years.

Students who complete the program will be qualified to find jobs as entry-level HVAC technicians. Those familiar with computers and electronics and individuals with good troubleshooting skills will have the best job opportunities.
