 and how the scholarship will meet
 these things
- Applicant is required to submit the 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid.
- If FAFSA is not submitted, applicant is required to submit copy of 2020 Federal Tax Return for student (and parent(s) if student is dependent)

OVERVIEW

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to two graduating sophomore students who are transferring to a four-year university, in the field of teaching education. Funds are provided by the Olney Central College Foundation through the Frances L. Stencel Teaching Scholarship Fund.
