

HELEN AND CHARLES CAMPBELL PRACTICAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

DESCRIPTION:

The **HELEN AND CHARLES CAMPBELL PRACTICAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP FUND** has been established to assist those non-traditional students pursuing a Nursing Degree at Wabash Valley College. The scholarship has been made possible through the generosity of the family of the late Helen and Charles Campbell, parents of the late Claire Locke of Mt. Carmel and Joyce Beals of Portland, Oregon. This is a one-year award that covers up to 15 credit hours of in-district tuition.

REQUIREMENTS/CRITERIA:

1. Applicants must complete and file an official application and any required materials by the deadline date as predetermined by the Foundation Scholarship Committee.
2. The Foundation Scholarship Committee for the selection of this award shall include a WVC nursing staff member, who serves in an advisory role.
3. The recipient shall be determined prior to the beginning of Fall Semester of the award year.
4. Character, disposition, and interest in successfully completing the practical nursing certificate and in pursuing employment in the practical nursing field shall be factors in determining selection.
5. Need shall be a factor in the case of equally qualified applicants.
6. If the student should withdraw from the course at the end of the first semester, the grant may be given to another applicant for the second semester tuition, if additional funds are available.
7. Upon verification of enrollment, the award is to be paid directly to the College toward tuition or books, or to the uniform supplier toward uniform costs, unless the recipient has already paid these expenses and has supplied receipts for reimbursement of these costs.

THE RECIPIENT:

- a. **Must have graduated from a Wabash County high school/homeschool at least 12 months prior to the award year.**
- b. **May also qualify if residency in Wabash County has been established for the past two years. (High school graduation still must be at least 12 months prior to the award year.)**
- c. Must meet the requirements to enter the first level of the ADN program.
- d. Must be currently in good standing academically at WVC with no less than a 2.5 overall grade point average.
- e. Must not have been convicted of a felony or charge of substance abuse.
