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THE FAIRFIELD BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Fairfield Business and Professional Women's Foundation has created scholarships and will offer them to Mature Females of Wayne County.

By offering these scholarships the FF BPW demonstrates its support for mature women who wish to return to college and their futures in the Wayne County area. The purpose of the scholarships is to create an opportunity for the recipients to attend college who might not otherwise have had that opportunity.

The criteria for becoming a scholarship recipient are:

- 1. The applicant must be a sincere female over the age of 21 and reside in Wayne County, Illinois.
- 2. The scholarship will be based on intelligence, industry, initiative, integrity, and ingenuity in pursuit of further education.
- The Student must pursue a degree at an accredited university, college or community college, and must attend an educational institution as defined in the Internal Revenue Code Section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii).
- 4. Each applicant must provide a written request for consideration, and demonstrate a financial need.
- 5. Documents submitted with the application must include the following:
 - (a) Three letters of recommendation from persons who are not related to the student.
 - (b) List of community activities participated in.
 - (c) Goals and objectives of the student and how they coincide with the proposed degree objectives.

The student should apply by sending the documents to the Advisory Committee.

The number and amount of the scholarships will be determined by the Advisory Committee of The Foundation and will be disbursed in two increments annually.

The recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale and remain a student as classified by the school to receive second semester and subsequent awards.
