

WHAT IS TRIO UPWARD BOUND?

TRIO Upward Bound is a college prep program funded by the U.S. Department of Education designed to assist high school students with the academic skills and motivation necessary for success in high school and beyond. We are funded to serve 208 students from 12 high schools located in the district.

TRIO Upward Bound specializes in college preparation and enrichment by providing tutorial services and academic assistance to students. In addition, TRIO Upward Bound involves students in numerous college & career experiences



Eligibility

Students eligible to apply to our program must attend North Clay, Grayville, Mount Carmel, Red Hill, Lawrenceville, Oblong, Robinson, Newton, Clay City, Edwards County, Fairfield Community, Richland County High School or reside in the target area. Our program also seeks to serve first-generation and/or income eligible (as defined by the U.S. Department of Education) college bound students.

ACADEMIC YEAR PROGRAM:

After school college preparation, tutorial, and counseling sessions

Individualized career/college counseling

4 Saturday Workshops throughout the school year, designed to further educate and motivate students.

SUMMER PROGRAM

Our Summer Session is offered at Olney Central College with FREE transportation, social / recreational / leadership activities, and a FREE summer trip.

FRESHMEN

SOPHOMORE

Enrollment in a three-credit course at OCC College information, activities, and speakers Weekly college visits.

JUNIOR

Enrollment in a three-credit hour course at OCC.
Practical experience at an approved work site.
Career information, activities, and speakers

SENIOR

Enrollment in up to 6 credit hours on any IECC campus.

Selection is based on academic potential for success in college, a need for support in order to succeed in education beyond high school, and motivation to participate in the program throughout high school.

The TRIO Upward Bound programs are 100% federally funded by the Department of Education for \$324,979 (LTC), \$376,462 (OCC), and \$309,505 (WVC).

Application to the program does not guarantee admission. Eligible students who are not selected due to space limitations will be placed on a waiting list until space becomes available.
