COURSE TYPE

Type A	Class at the high school, taught by a high school employee
Type B	Class at the high school, taught by an IECC employee
Type C	IECC class online, distance learning, or co-taught with an IECC employee
Type D	Class on an IECC campus or satellite location, taught by an IECC employee

Priority Course

Courses that are part of the Three to Your Degree program, which focuses on course that are included in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI).

Priority Career Pathway Course

A career-focused course that has been identified by the school, after consultation with the college, as an early college credit course within a career-focused instructional sequence as part of College & Career Pathway Endorsement System.

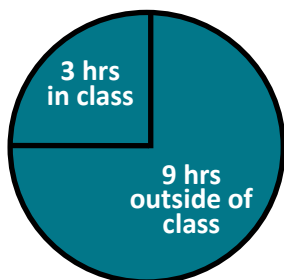
Non-Priority Course

Any other course offered as dual credit that does not fit into Priority Courses or Priority Career Pathway Courses.
