DESCRIPTION:

The CIO directs a high-performing IT team, ensuring that technology operations remain efficient and responsive to evolving District needs. Additionally, the CIO leads timely updates and enhancement of critical IT systems, including Ellucian/Banner, to support the institution's mission and goals.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree in information technology or computer science related field required. Master's degree preferred. Five years' experience managing technology resources and/or information systems with increasing level of responsibility throughout. Experience with Ellucian/Banner software preferred. Successful applicant must have excellent written and verbal communication skills; ability to make decisions in accordance with policies, rules and regulations; ability to work independently under pressure to meet deadlines; and ability to interact effectively with administration, faculty, and staff.
