Truck Driver Training Program in Noble, IL and Fairfield, IL starting in the summer of 2024. Primary responsibilities are to provide instruction on the safe operation of tractor-trailers using both classroom and behind-the-wheel training to students in the Truck Driver Training Program that culminates in a student testing for CDL licensure at the DMV. Classes are offered during the day and evenings to traditional and adult

learners. Adjunct instructors will participate in assessment activities.

required. Clean motor vehicle record and a thorough knowledge of truck driving laws and safety procedures required. Current DOT medical card required. Successful college teaching experience including computer-assisted, multi-media instruction, and innovative teaching techniques preferred (but not required). Daytime availability
