DESCRIPTION: The Illinois Eastern Community College District has three openings for a part time Nursing Tutor, one at Frontier Community College, Lincoln Trail College, and Wabash Valley College. This position will tutor students to facilitate their success in Nursing specific courses. They will meet with student individually and in groups to support them as they review and learn concepts taught in class, campus labs, and agency lab. The Nursing Tutor will help students apply nursing concepts and think critically about course content and its application. This position will work with faculty to develop and supply supplemental instruction which supports end or course learning outcomes.
