

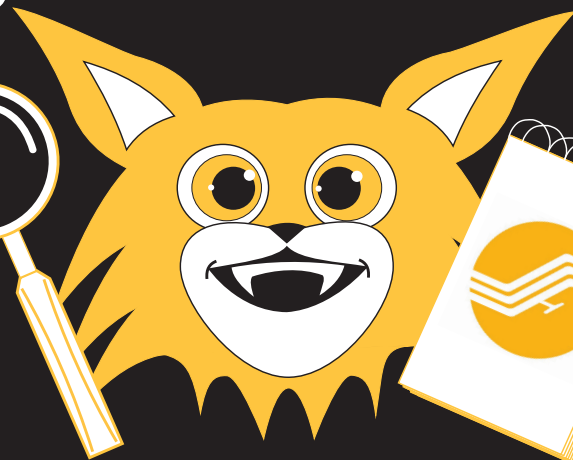

HOW TO REGISTER

The easiest way to register is by visiting Student Services at Frontier Community College.

Early registration is recommended because class sizes are limited.

Registration and Confirmation

Pre-Registration is required for all classes. Student signature and payment are required at registration. Classes can fill up quickly, so early registration is encouraged. Confirmation of registration will include a course schedule, receipt, and other information specific to the enrolled classes. Students under age 18 require a parent/guardian's signature on registration documents.

Cost

Classes require pre-registration and payment. Registrations are not valid until payment is received.

Enrollment and Cancellation

If a class reaches enrollment capacity, a waitlist will be created for the class. Students should provide current contact information including phone number and an active email address so students can be notified if class information changes or a class is cancelled. Classes are subject to cancellation if the minimum enrollment is not attained. In the event of cancellation, students will be notified. Some classes have limited enrollment due to space or other limitations.

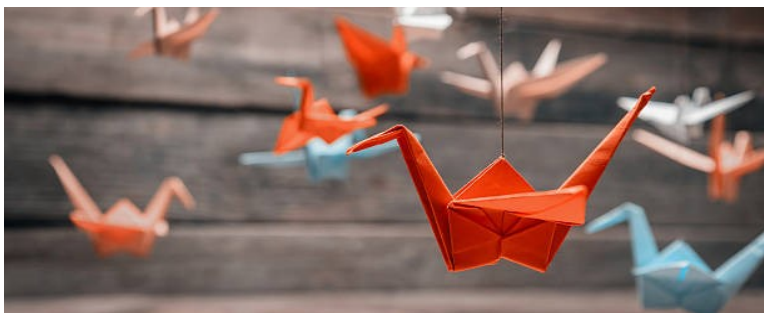
Explore science with to hands-on fun science projects that spark learning. Perform hands-on experiments
