DESCRIPTION: Frontier Community College is seeking adjunct instructors to teach in the Truck Driving Program starting in the Fall 2022 or Spring 2023 semester. QUALIFICATIONS: Class A CDL license and a minimum of three years of truck driving experience required. Successful college teaching experience including computer-assisted, multi-media instruction, and innovative teaching techniques preferred (but not required).
