For an independent student to be considered a resident of Illinois, s/he must have physically resided in Illinois (at the time of application), and has so resided for 12 continuous full months immediately **prior to the start of the academic year** for which assistance is requested and Illinois must be his/her true, fixed, and permanent home.

- Student's valid 2019 State of Illinois income tax return or federal tax transcript;
- Illinois high school or Illinois college transcript showing attendance in the 2019-2020 academic year.
- Illinois driver's license issued prior to August 20, 2019.
- Utility or rent bills in the student's name dated prior to August 20, 2019.
- Illinois auto registration card issued prior to August 20, 2019.
- 2019 Wage and tax statements (IRS Form W-2).
- Statement of 2019 benefits history from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services
- Residential lease in the student's name dated prior to August 20, 2019.
- Statement of 2019 benefits from the Illinois Department of Employment Security;
- State of Illinois Identification Card issued by the Secretary of State prior to August 20, 2019.
- Statement of 2019 benefits from the Social Security Administration.
- Illinois voter's registration card issued prior to August 20, 2019.
- 2019 Illinois Property tax bill.
- 2019 IRS Form 1099-Miscellaneous Income Statements.
