The TRIO Upward Bound programs are 100% federally funded by the Department of Education. Illinois Eastern Community Colleges has been awarded \$972,064 to administer the TRIO Upward Bound programs.

DESCRIPTION: IECC's TRIO Upward Bound Program has an opening for Assistant Director. The Assistant

Director is responsible for managing components of the TRIO program in compliance with the grant proposal, federal legislation, regulations, and guidance. Other responsibilities include evaluating, improving, and implementing precollege services that increase high school achievement, college admissions, and college graduation rates for participants.

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in counseling, psychology, social work, education or related field

required; Master's degree preferred. Ability to communicate and work well with participants, parents/guardians and high school personnel required. The position requires a demonstrated commitment to economically disadvantaged and first-generation youth; and the ability to understand and accept varied lifestyles. Personal experience in overcoming academic and economic obstacles to success preferred. Valid driver's license and an ability to work

independently and travel extensively within the target area required.

LOCATION: This position will be located at one of the locations within the IECC District. Potential

worksites include Fairfield, IL, Robinson, IL, Olney, IL, or Mt. Carmel, IL.
