- Description:** The Program Director of Academic Advising provides strategic leadership and oversight for advising services across the district. This position is responsible for ensuring a consistent, high-quality advising experience that supports student enrollment, retention, persistence, and completion. The Program Director of Academic Advising directs advising staff, manages training and information systems collaboratively with the Director of Advising Systems, and collaborates with campus and district partners to improve student success outcomes. This position requires regular travel between all four campuses and a flexible schedule, including evenings or weekends as needed. The Program Director of Academic Advising reports directly to the Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs.
- Qualifications:** Bachelor's degree in education, counseling, or related field. Master's degree preferred. 5+ years of experience in academic advising or student services. Demonstrated leadership or supervisory experience. Strong communication, organization, and problem-solving skills. Experience with student information systems and advising technologies.
