Title IX Protects people from discrimination based on sex (including pregnancy, sexual orientation, and gender identity) in education programs or activities that receive federal financial assistance. This includes Sexual Harassment & Sexual Violence

Sexual Violence is any sexual contact or behavior that happens without your consent.
