April 22, 2025

ISAB President Mireya Rose called the meeting to order.

ISAB Membership for the 2025-2026 Academic Year

New Student Organization Application – An application was received to recognize the LTC Fellowship of Christian Athletes as a student organization. Kylee Hosman s described the purpose of the organization and their activities. Funding Requests: Several funding requests were considered this month. Prior to these funding requests being considered, it was reported that ISAB has recommended funding of student events and activities in the amount of \$28,679.89 to date. The following funding requests were considered:

- d. OCC – PTK members attended Catalyst, Student Senate held Spring Fling, Future Educators held an egg hunt, and students helped with the Flora HS testing day
- e. WVC – Archery team competed at SI-C and French Lick, Diesel Club visited CAT in Decatur and participated in the Carquest appreciation day, Student Senate/Int'l Program/FRESH held a campus wide egg hunt, pancake night is 4/29, Spring Fling is 4/30, and a tennis clinic is on 4/30
