Other duties include assisting in the development of forms and handbooks, planning and chaperoning trips and data entry, and maintaining contact with teachers and parents/guardians regarding students' academic, personal, career and programmatic development. Employment is contingent

upon continued grant funding. The site assignment will be Lincoln Trail College in

Robinson, Illinois.

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in counseling, psychology, social work, education or related field

required; Master's degree preferred. Ability to communicate and work well with participants, parents/guardians and high school personnel required. The position requires a demonstrated commitment to first-generation youth; and the ability to understand and provide guidance to all participants. Personal experience in overcoming academic and economic obstacles to success preferred. Valid driver's

license and an ability to work independently and travel extensively within the target area

required.
