Mary E. Hartrich Nursing Scholarship

The Mary E. Hartrich Nursing Scholarship is awarded every two years to a First-Level Nursing student with demonstrated need for financial assistance and ability to complete the program. Should the recipient fail to complete his or her program, the scholarship will become void. Financial need will be the primary consideration for the award, which will not discriminate among applicants on the basis of race, gender, creed, or political persuasion.

The scholarship will fund one student who has gained acceptance into the Nursing Program for a period of two years. The scholarship can be applied to costs of tuition, application fees, lab fees, modules and textbooks, support books, insurance, uniforms, pins, graduation fees, State Board Testing and NCLEX Review. Only interest from the Mary Hartrich Nursing Scholarship can be used to award each year. Because of this, the value of the award may vary year to year.

Students who have not filed a 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be required to submit copies of their 2021 federal tax returns and those of their parents (if they are dependent students).
