## **Preventing Sexual Harassment & Assault**

It is your right to report (or not report) an instance of sexual harassment or assault.



## What is Consent?

Consent is a freely given agreement to engage in sexual activity. Consent can be withdrawn at any time. Consent cannot be given when a person is unable to understand the nature of the activity or cannot consent based on circumstances, including but not limited to:

- Incapacitation due to the influence of drugs or alcohol
- The person is asleep or unconscious
- The person is not of legal age to consent
- The threat of force is used
- The person is incapacitated due to a mental disability

Consent must be given each time parties engage in sexual activity. Consent given on a prior occasion does not indicate future consent.

## **How to Report Sexual Harassment or Assault**

Prevail Illinois provides free, confidential advisors. These advisors are not required to report any information about an incident to the Title IX Coordinator without a victim's permission.
