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consist of a re-design of the current floor plan(s) of the existing restrooms. This re-design would include the removal and reduction of commode stalls to accommodate individuals in wheelchairs and other physical limitations. Washing sinks would require adjustment to necessary minimum heights to ensure proper access. Some of our existing wash sinks currently have exposed plumbing that require insulation or other protective barriers. Entryways to restrooms would require reconfiguration to allow for minimum width and clearance requirements as well as purchase and installation of automatic door openers to accommodate entrance to the restrooms.

Restrooms selected for this project will primarily target those used by students and guests of the District. Access to facilities, such as restrooms, improves the student and visitor experience. Hundreds of guests visit the restrooms at our performing arts centers of the District each year. Events include conferences, plays, and musical performances.
