- One letter of recommendation from an arts mentor/professional in the field
- One professional reference letter (ex. employer, community leader, volunteer supervisor)
- A resume emphasizing your involvement in arts related activities
- A brief narrative of no more than 500 words describing how you intend to pursue and mature through the arts during your educational career
- A portfolio of your work
 - Performing Arts – (3-5 diverse examples of solo or small ensemble performances)
 - Visual Arts – Portfolio of work in a variety of media (6-8 diverse examples)

**** Successful scholarship applicants will be issued a check directly upon proof of enrollment (class schedule). If requirements cannot be met by November 1, 2023, the scholarship is forfeited.**
